BANGALORE HEALTH FESTIVAL STALL BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Bangalore Health Festival, is being organised by TV House Network (Bangalore) Pvt. Ltd. in association with the Government of Karnataka Departments of Health, Family Welfare and Tourism along with the Event Coordinators Abhinava Events. This Festival is an interaction and interface between the healthcare industry and the good health seeking general public. In view of the same, there shall be stalls put up during the said Festival, subject to certain terms and conditions. Stalls shall be hired by "stall holders" by paying the amount for the stalls as decided by the Organizers. By agreeing to put up stalls and making the necessary payments, the stall holders and/or their representatives acknowledge and agree with the following terms and conditions;

- a) This festival is being held in the city of Bengaluru for four (4) days, i.e., from 4th May to 7th May, 2017 at Tripura Vasini, Palace Grounds. However, in case the event gets cancelled on the dates mentioned hereinabove, the Organisers/Event Coordinators shall reorganize the festival on or before 30th September, 2017 and the same shall be intimated to all the stall holder. Amount paid for the stalls shall not be reimbursed if the Festival is reorganized on or before 30th September, 2017; otherwise, the organizers/event coordinators shall reimburse the amount paid by the stall holders upon submission of this Form and the bill.
- b) The stall put up in the Festival shall be related to healthcare and its ancillaries only.
- c) The stall holders are bound to make the entire payment for the stall including taxes before 4th May, 2017. If full payment is not made before 4th May 2017, the Organizers retain the discretion to resell the stall to any third party. In such a case, the advance amount paid shall stand to be forfeited. However, if the stall owner fails to occupy and/or set up the stall, payment made for such stalls shall be forfeited.
- d) All products displayed in the stall shall be original and duplicate products shall not be permitted.
- e) The stall holder shall be provided with stall structure, table, chairs, power socket and carpeted floor area, by the Organizers/Event coordinators for setting up their stalls. The same shall be returned back to the Organizers/Event coordinators at the end of the Festival, without any damages. In case of misplacement or damage of the materials provided, the stall holder shall bear the cost for the same.
- f) The stalls should be ready before the inauguration of the event. The stall holder shall not be permitted to set up the stall after the inauguration.
- g) The stall holder and their designated representatives are required to carry their identity cards issued by the Organizers at all times and upon request the same shall be provided to the Organizers and/or their representatives.
- h) Any third party related to the stall holder without an ID card shall not be permitted to enter the stall, unless they register at the entrance and obtain written permission from the Organizers.
- i) The stall holder is entitled to request for a different stall by stating reasons for the change of the stall and in case the Organizers are satisfied with the said reasons and based on the availability of stalls, the Organizers may accommodate and provide a different stall.
- j) The Organizers, keeping in mind the interest of the Festival at large, hold the right to change the stall and accommodate the stall holder in a different stall, by ensuring that the interest of the stall holders are protected. The same shall not be questioned by the stall holder.
- k) No food or beverage consumption shall be permitted inside the stalls or in the general area where the Festival is being conducted.
- l) Each stall holder shall be responsible to comply with the relevant taxes and the Organizers shall be indemnified from the same.
- m) The stall holder shall ensure that there shall be no display of any product or service outside the allocated stall area of their respective stall.
- n) Stall Holder is prohibited from playing loud music or making loud noise during the Festival and shall ensure that the neighbouring stalls are not disturbed under any circumstance.
- o) Stall Holders are prohibited from using hazardous materials and/or explosives/infectious substances within the premises of the Festival.
- p) The stall area shall remain safe to all the guests/visitors and passers-by and the stall holder and/or their representatives shall ensure that no harm is caused to anyone in the premises
- q) The stall holder/representatives shall maintain professionalism through the said Festival and shall treat the guest/visitors visiting their stall with good conduct and serve them in the best manner possible.
- r) The stall owner and their representatives shall not do any act which is detrimental to the Festival and shall at all times act in a responsible manner and protect the interest of the Organizers and the Festival
- s) There shall be no glaring lights; fire or heat generating devices or equipment in the stalls. If any harm is caused to any third party in the Festival premises areas including the stall by the stall holder or their representatives during the said festival, the said stall holder and/or their representatives shall be held responsible and suitable action shall be taken against them.
- t) Any equipment placed inside the stall shall be the responsibility of the stall holder or their representatives.
- u) The stall holder shall install devices for management of fluctuation of electricity for safety of equipment or other devices.
- v) The stall holder shall get in touch with the Organizers/Event Coordinators in case they need any arrangements to be made for their stall, at their cost.
- w) The Organizer reserves the right to close/shut down the stall at their discretion with immediate effect at any time prior to or during the course of the Festival in the event of breach of any of these terms and conditions mentioned above or in the event of any misconduct by either the stall holder or their representatives or anyone associated to the stall. In the event of such breach or termination, amount paid by the stall holder shall not be refunded.
- x) In case the stall holder decides to discontinue his/her stall at any point during the Festival, the Organizers must be intimated in writing and no amount shall be refunded to the stall holder.
- y) In the event of occurrence of any natural calamity like earthquake, fire, flood, or any act of God or in the event of any unforeseen events during the Festival, both the parties shall be exempted from performance/ discharge of their respective work or obligations and the Organizers shall not be made liable for any loss or damage and the stall holder shall not be refunded.
- z) In the event of any disputes/ differences arising out of or in relation to stalls, between the parties, then the parties shall endeavour to resolve the disputes/ differences amicably.
- aa) The laws of India and the local laws of Karnataka shall be applicable for the execution and interpretation of the said terms and conditions. The Courts at Bangalore City shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try and entertain matters pertaining to the terms and conditions.
